Before Play

- Wear shoes and clothes appropriate for exercise.
- Play with up to 4 people in a group.
- Everyone should use different colored balls.
- Treat the grass and the trees with respect.
- Be safe: don't stand in front of players ready to hit the ball, wait for players ahead to move out of the way, etc.
- Learn the rules of the course you are on.






Park Golf Equipment













You must hit the ball from a tee on the teeing ground.

Tips for improving

- Watch your club hit the ball (keep your eye on the ball).
- Try to hit the ball with the club face sweet spot.



Keep in mind

- Misses do not count as strokes.
- If you swing the club and the ball moves, it counts as a stroke.
- Use a marker to mark the place of an obstructing ball when moved out of the way.



After teeing off, the person whose ball is furthest from the hole

goes first.



In case of

Around the green



Write scores down after moving to the next hole. The person with the lowest score on the previous hole goes first.

Unplayable ball

If it is too difficult to hit the ball from where it lies, you can move it one club distance, but not closer to the hole, and then add one stroke to your score for the hole.

OB (Out of Bounds)

From the spot where the ball went out of bounds, measure two club lengths onto the fairway but not closer to the hole.
